Code of Ethics

- 1. Concrete petrographers shall not engage in work in which they are not competent, unless under the guidance and direction of a concrete petrographer experienced and competent in that particular work.
- 2. Concrete petrographers must meet the qualification requirements defined in the Qualifications Section of ASTM C856, "Standard Practice for Petrographic Examination of Hardened Concrete".
- 3. Advice, opinions, and judgments shall be objective, consistent, and based on competency and experience in the matters involved and not in disagreement with technical and scientific principles.
